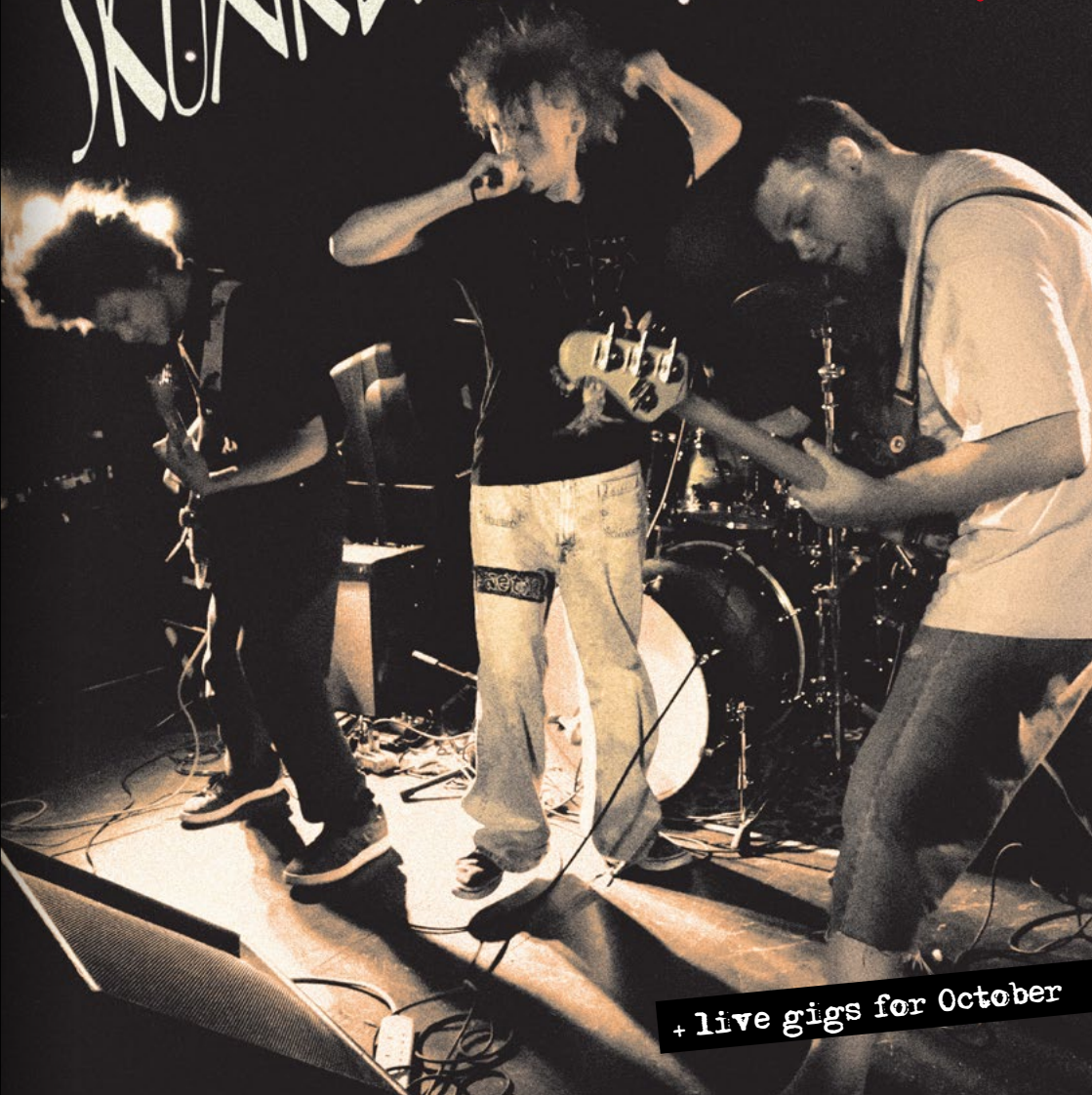

Skunkworm consists of Harrison (vocals, sort of gothy), Spike on bass, Harvey guitar and Freddie on drums. Like all the greatest they are visually fun and really perform, jumping off amps, two stepping and twitching violently (Harrison also has great hair). Harvey Spike and Harrison knew each other before the band, they were in a band before this that was "pretty shit. It was called Antirupt. It was like a hardcore band. We just wanted to punch people, but we didn't get to that stage. We didn't make a single song!"

"No. Actually, we wrote one, you just didn't learn it. It was rubbish."

SPIKE: We've existed since around March this year. Harrison was the link between us all since he knew all of us from previous bands.

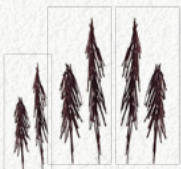
Harrison: I messaged Freddie then I messaged Harvey then I messaged Spike. Then we jammed. Wrote a silly song (aforementioned)...

HARVEY: With an epic reggae section!

What inspirations influence their music? What made them want to make their own music rather than just listen?

HARVEY: Siamese Dreams by Smashing Pumpkins, Unknown Pleasures by Joy Division and Only Theatre Of Pain by Christian Death. And Guitar Hero! That shit looked cool but then I realised I could just learn real guitar.

SPIKE: At the moment there's this compilation of late 70s/early 80s New York underground post punk/dance called New York Noise by Soul Jazz records which I'm listening to a lot, Daydream Nation by Sonic Youth, Skinty Fia by Fontaines D.C., Spiderland by Slint, then there's Fugazi, Title Fight, IDLES... I could go on for hours. Bullet In A Bible (Green Day live album from Milton Keynes Bowl in 2005) made me wanna make my own music... to the extent that when I was very young, I dressed up as Billie Joe Armstrong fairly often.



HARRISON: My favourite record is Pornography by The Cure. It's one of the most harrowing vocal and lyrical performances I've ever heard and that's a big influence on my singing. I also find inspiration in bands like Amebix, The Birthday Party, and Christian Death. Oh, and Saetia. I guess listening to stuff like Royal Blood and Red-Hot Chilli Peppers when I was about 11 or 12 made me want to make music and not just listen.

Music is the most fulfilling way to make things. More so than drawing or sewing for me.

FREDDIE(drums): My favourite album of all time is Jane Doe by Converge because of its intensity and relentlessness, it's one of my main inspirations in my drumming. Some other inspirations are Black Midi, Lightning Bolt, Dillinger Escape Plan and Hella. When I first heard Slipknot when I was 9, that's what made me want to play drums and make music.

What's been their favourite gig so far? What's their favourite place to play?

SPIKE: This one! This has been our biggest audience, and it was pretty much all people we didn't know! Stuff went wrong but we powered through and sounded the best we probably ever have. Harvey broke a string, and me and Freddie played some random covers of stuff like Daft Punk Is Playing At My House and Psycho Killer while he fixed it. I dived onto the floor at the end of the set then tried to do a forward roll and squashed my own hand and broke my cable. Good times.

Close second is the time we played at the Queens Head (Farnham) because we got to play with my very good friends Acid Splash and they're a great band. That's my favourite venue, cos it's so tiny that it always feels busy.



HARVEY: My favourite was either the Dead Sound Promotions 'Battle of the Bands' final at The Queens Head or the second time we played Boileroom in Guildford. Best place might be the Rising Sun Arts Centre in Reading.

HARRISON: Favourite gig AND place to play was here. It was our first time playing a set of all originals. The venue is stunning too.

FREDDIE: Either this one or the Queens Head finale gig. I think the best place to play is probably the Queens head.

Harrison is the mastermind behind their logo and the cover for their demo (on Soundcloud, now) and merch and some posters. And Spike has recently drawn up a couple posters for gigs purely out of boredom. ■
