See you out there, once I've got the sand out. - RiCH





It's an unusual propostition, at first. I've said it's made of just one person but, if you've never seen Baby Maker, don't go picturing any acoustic guitar singer/songwriter-y thing cos it's not that. What you have here, is some pretty sparse backing tracks accompanying some very tasty bass playing mixing a bit of a funk thing with a big spoonful of old school post-punk/ new wave style. All of which sits behind a very cool, laid back, half sung, half spoken vocal that comes across almost as poetry.

Think Baxter or Ian Dury (depending on your age bracket!), plus a drop of Iggy Pop and you won't be a million miles off, including Ruairi's solid statement of fact: "Norman Watt-Roy: sick bassist"

So, this one-man show, part live, part prerecorded... is that someone who's played in bands but turned control freak, or a studio project that has escaped into the wild, or what?

It turns out to be a bit both. There might have been a band once upon a time, but the desire to get out and do it kicked in quicker than the finding other people to get involved.

"My brother was doing a lot of drums initially but he didn't really want to do it live and I was, like, 'I really need to start playing'."

"So it was more of a necessity than first choice to start with. I'd only played in bands before. I'd never... I was lead singer for one band — a one-gig wonder — but, yeah, I was kinda bricking it to be honest and the first few were pretty rusty but I've got used to doing it that way."

For my money, it has worked out nice. When you watch Baby Maker, nothing looks or sounds like it's missing and a handful of other people hanging about on stage would kind of detract from the knowing vocal, sometimes a bit playful, sometimes a bit sinister, that sits in amongst the heavy groove thing.

At midnight tonight, after this gig, a new Baby Maker track gets released into the wild. It's called 'I'd Rather Be In Berlin' which, of course, begs the question: Why?

"It's just escapism, isn't it, really. I was in a job that I really didn't enjoy by the end. I quit and then, after my last day, that song just kind of fell out, really. It could have been anywhere, I think... it's just about being fed up of monotony or whatever and just wanting to do something else."

It's a belter. 'I'd rather be queuing up for Berghain knowing that I won't get in.' is the best lyric to describe absolute boredom that I've heard in a long time but the lyrical highlight of this ode to ennui is the last line. I won't spoil it for you – you'll have to turn up and listen.

"Turn up" you say? Where, then? Practically on your doorstep... twice! Baby Maker will be in the Rising Sun Arts Centre at either end of August: the 9th as part of the Here Comes The Sun festival and the 29th for Club Velocity along with Pink Diamond Revue and and Tashi Delay.

In the meantime, you can hear 'I'd Rather Be In Berlin' everywhere you'd expect to. Go to Bandcamp and you'll also find last year's album 'From The Desk Of'.

We received a gruesome collection of horror on DVD. Including the classic Giallo, Tenebrae by il maestro del paura, Dario Argento. Top recommendation. New York Ripper isn't a recommendation but is the most infamous film by another Italian director, Lucio Fulci and well thought of by connoisseurs of Italian hard



exploitation cinema, if not by me. Brain Damage is by Frank Henenlotter, the doge of 80s lo-fi punky creature features. If you've seen his grimly humorous Basketcase. you'll like it. I haven't seen *Shark Exorcist*.



We have been lucky to have a succession of very nice Soul CDs donated recently. Including some titles on the superb Kent Records label. In terms of selection, mastering, scholarship etc, they are tip top. Originally a real deal US R&B label based in LA, since the 80s it became UK based Ace records primo soul imprint.

It's tempting to believe there are literally an infinite number of banging soul records from the 1960s but I understand that's impossible.

We sell comics! Generally organised into bundles of consecutive titles for practical reading purposes. At the moment, mostly lots of interesting superhero titles from the 1990s and subsequently. 



Shadow Promotions DIY

You know The Butler, don't you... sitting over there on Chatham Street like the Face Bar's gobby little brother. Well, in case you hadn't noticed there's been a string of punk gigs going on there for a while now put on Shadow Promotions DIY and they're sort of not 'normal'; they're often on a Sunday afternoon, for a start, and there could be anything up eight bands on at a time. And, if they're not in The Butler, they're putting punk gigs on in The Castle Tap - a pub so small you not going to believe it until you see it.

This particular Sunday, there are only five bands so, once everything is set up, there's time to speak to them and find out what you need to know.

I've got James Foster, Guy Mitchell and Dan Tape here and there's a Zara around somewhere too, completing the team. So, first off, when and why did they start all this?

Guy: We had the idea about two summers ago. March/ April 2023 we conceived it. I guess the reason we did it was. Jim moved to Reading, I'm in Fleet so not far very away and there wasn't that much going on here.

With no pevious form at all?

Well... I used to be in a band. Dan's in a band. Jim's not in a band but we've been listening to punk rock and stuff since we were like 17 or something.

Jim: I think for us it started in Brighton about 25 years ago. I was at Uni. Guy was the partner of somebody I was looking to move in it with. It was one of those moments where like, you were wearing a Capdown T-shirt and we just kind of hit it off. And in Brighton in the early 2000s you had such a good scene.

G: They did a thing called Sunday Service where every other Sunday it was just all day punk rock and ska. Ten bands and it was just ten guid to get in.

Then, when we moved this way, we thought 'rather than going to bands, let's bring them to us'.

J: The ethos was... we enjoyed that when we were younger, can we create that for the next generation people.



Who was on the first one?

Dan: Filthy Militia, Tape It Shut, Baldhead & the Dreads, Prev and Launch Control

J: Having Dan who's in the scene and in a band has helped us a lot, actually.

D: We [Tape It Shut] sort of settled in to being your house band, and helping put it on...

G: Basically, we booked Tape It Shut because they had a drum kit!

D: ...and now you're stuck with it!

Over that time, then... any particularly standout gigs?

G: I'd say Random Hand was our best one because we sold it out.

D: All the support acts were local punk rock bands with the idea of getting more people to local shows because people would travel in for Random Hand and got to see a big sample of what Reading's like with III Gotten Gains, Rage DC, Launch Control and ourselves.

Word has definitely got round. People now come to Reading from all over for these gigs

We've had people from Ireland come over... Fred from Scotland, he came down for a show... there were people from France at that Random Hand show... somebody from Germany came to another one. We get a lot of people from Bristol, London and Oxford.

G: We are now, apparently, 'on the circuit'. We've got bands from America coming over, Australia, the Netherlands... we've got loads coming up, from everywhere.

8 Kalacas [from California] was a bit of a highlight...

J: The heat in there was so hot, people couldn't take photos on their phones... people's phones stopped working because of the heat!



So that's where Shadow Promotions DIY are now; with bands from literally all over the world, wanting to come and play here in Reading and be a part of the scene they've helped build. Not bad going, at all.


